SUMMARY DESCRIPTION

Faculty of Administrative Studies. Office of the Dean.
Records, 1965 - 1981. 53 boxes, 53 Feet.

Includes textual and graphic material. Comprised of administrative records of the office and of the Faculty, personnel files of staff and faculty, financial records of the faculty, minutes of faculty and departmental committees, promotional literature, reports and some lectures and instructional material. Forms of records include in and out correspondence and memoranda, original typescript minutes and copies of minutes, brochures and pamphlets produced by the Faculty and received by it from outside sources, and computer print-outs. There are also photographs, some used for the Faculty Calendar and audio-visual material relating to the teaching of French. The records were received in two separate accession at three times: Accession 1, 42 boxes, was received on July 25 1985. An addition to accession 1, 10 boxes, was received on January 14 1987. The second accession, 4 boxes, was received on January 14 1988. The records are arranged in FIVE series reflecting the organization maintained in the Office:

File titles used by the office were retained with some standardization. Acid-free stock was used to enclose the files. Duplicates only were culled.
