

### SERIES LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

S 1. Correspondence and papers, 1947-1979, contains correspondence with individuals and institutions, arranged alphabetically, as well as files of correspondence that are arranged chronologically. Included in the named correspondents are the American Academy of Asian Studies, the American Society of Clinical Hypnosis, Emma Jung, Jay Albrecht, Michael S. Broder, the Centre for the Whole Person (includes legal agreements, publicity, history), the Esalen Institute, Arthur Janov, Ronald Laing, Abraham H. Maslow, Carl Rogers, Thomas R. Verney and Alan Watts. There are also books of messages from friends on the death of Swartley.

S 2. Notes, 1944-1979, contain notes on courses and writings for academic work, an attempt at an autobiography, notes on Swartley's dreams, poetry, notes and drafts for speeches, typescripts of articles and writings of Swartley's dealing with forms of psychotherapy.

S 3. Author and subject catalogue cards, contain bibliographic references for Swartley's research.

S 4. Writings and related papers, 1947-1978, include drafts, and typescripts of articles and translations done by Swartley, including his introduction to Broder's 'An eclectic approach to primal integration,' (1976), as well as papers, articles, and printed material relating to the journal, 'Typology,' (1944-1977), which contains articles by Swartley. In addition, there is material related to the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator, including answered questionnaires from clients using the Myers-Briggs tests (1971-1975). There are also responses from Radio Corporation of America (RCA) personnel to Fleishman's Leadership Opinion Questionnaire (1962-1964).

S 5. Typescripts and reprints, 1906-1978, consists of materials gathered by Swartley in his analytical and research roles, including papers by Paul Bindrim on 'peak' psychology, Michael S. Broder, Loren Eisely, Stanislav Grof on LSD therapy, Raymond Leibl on primal therapy, Donald MacKinnon on creativity, and Maslow on self-actualization, among others.

S 6. Printed material, 1951-1979, consists of leaflets, articles and related material concerning the Centre for the Whole Person, including 'Primal classics,' (1974), 'Basic application of neo-Reichian methods to primal oriented therapy,' 'Guide to encounter groups,' and several titles by Swartley. There is also material from the Institute for Humanistic Psychology, the Denver Feeling Centre, Esalen Institute, the Gestalt Institute of Toronto, the Institute for Postural Integration, the International Primal Association, Inc., the Psychosynthesis Research Foundation, and other research and therapy bodies.

S 7. Newspaper clippings, 1961-1973, consists of scrapbooks of newspaper clippings, photographs and other material relating to the development of growth centres and encounter groups.

S 8. Photographs, consists of photographs of Swartley and family and travel photographs, as well as photocopied photographs from encounter groups.

S 9. Paintings, contain paintings by Swartley, as well as a portrait of him.

S 10. Films, consists of 'Birth film,' a forty-two minute colour film dealing with birthing methods; and 'Childhood II,' (1972), a colour film consisting of Swartley's psychotherapeutic techniques practised at a marathon weekend of healing.
