Scope and Content Note Accession consists of five series:
Subject Files: Correspondence and Clippings; Manuscripts; Paintings; Posters and Scrapbooks; Published Material; and Cartographic Materials.

The series of correspondence and clippings relate to Pollock's many interests, particularly in Temple Sinai, the James Joyce Society, and travel. The manuscripts are of plays that he wrote and directed, including multiple copies annotated for different purposes. Published material consists of 9 volumes of Thom's Directory (1852-1950) and one volume of The Dublin Almanac and General Register of Ireland (1847). The 15 watercolour paintings are by Jane Golden.

Immediate Source of Acquisition Gift of Harry Pollock.

Notes on Processing of the Materials Duplicates of pamphlets, programs, flyers etc. were discarded. Metal paper clips were replaced with plastic ones but metal staples were not removed. This should also be done at a later date.

Series 3 contains a poster for The Coach with the Six Insides. This poster was removed from its frame which in which it had been housed under glass. The frame was discarded.

Description of the Records by Series

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<u>Physical Description of Materials</u>	3 ft. (91 cm.) of textual records.
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<u>Scope and Content Note</u>	This series contains files pertaining to Professor Pollock's interests including Temple Sinai and the James Joyce Society. The files on the James Joyce Society pertain mainly to financial matters. This series has been arranged by Professor Pollock.
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This series also contains files on countries that Professor Pollock visited. These files may contain any of the following: Professor Pollock's notes, travel brochures, ticket stubs, receipts photographs, maps and newspaper clippings.

1.5 in. of material, consisting of theatre programs and correspondence with theatres, was found interleaved in the published materials. These materials were interfiled in this series. These files are so noted in the file list.

<u>Sources of Title Information</u>	Series title is based on the content of the materials.
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File titles were transcribed from the original file folders. Where there was information on the folders themselves the covers of the folders were included in the file. Any additions to the titles that were made are denoted by square brackets for example the title J. J. Society and Joyce Society were transcribed as J.[ames] J.[oyce] Society and [James] Joyce society respectively. The files were then arranged in alphabetical order.

**Notes on Processing of the
Materials**

Many of the files in this series contain news paper clippings. In some cases the clippings were photocopied and the originals discarded in other cases the clippings were separated from the rest of the papers in the file and were placed at the back of the file separated by acid free paper. These clippings are at varying stages of deterioration and should be photocopied and discarded at a later date.

File #104 contains a scrapbook of newspaper clippings which are at an advanced stage of deterioration. A photocopy has been made of the scrapbook which is held in file #105. Photographs have been removed from the original and interfiled in the photocopy. The original scrapbook should be micro filmed at a later date. It has been wrapped in acid free paper and boxed separately.
