Title: York University Provost fonds

Outside Dates: 1981-1989

Biographical Sketch: The first Provost was appointed in February 1984 by the

Board of Governors. The responsibilities of the Provost relate to student affairs and York community services. Several student societies, groups and services report through the Provost's Office including the Office of Student Affairs, the Counselling and Development Centre, the colleges, and Athletics and Recreation. In addition, the Provost takes the lead in the areas of human rights (Status of Women, Race Relations, Students with Disabilities), and is responsible for an arts portfolio which includes the Art Gallery of York University. In 1990 the position of Provost became a part of the Vice President (Campus Relations and Student Affairs). Thomas A. Meininger served as Provost from 1984-1989. Elizabeth D. Hopkins held the position for 1989-1990, and then became the first Vice President (Campus Relations and Student Affairs).

Scope and Content: The fonds consists of the records of the Provost, 1981-1989 and the Disciplinary Review Committee, 1984-1986,

General note: In addition to archival records, Archives and Special Collections has gathered other material from the Office of the Provost which is housed in the Ephemera collection. This material includes printed material and ephemera, including announcements of events, handbooks and reports.

Access restriction: Some access restrictions apply. Consult the University Archives for details. Material of a public nature is open.
